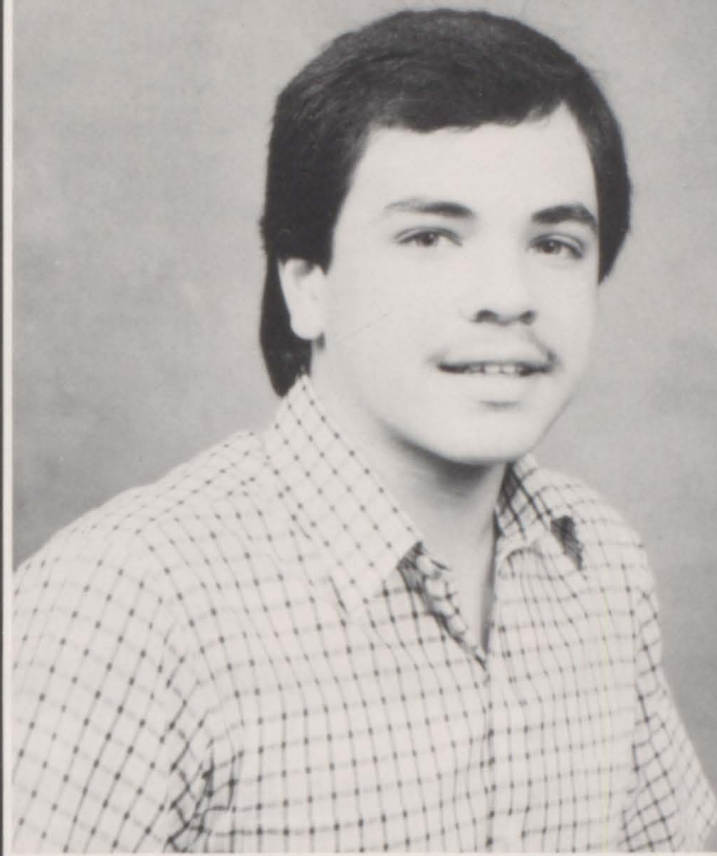
DEDICATION

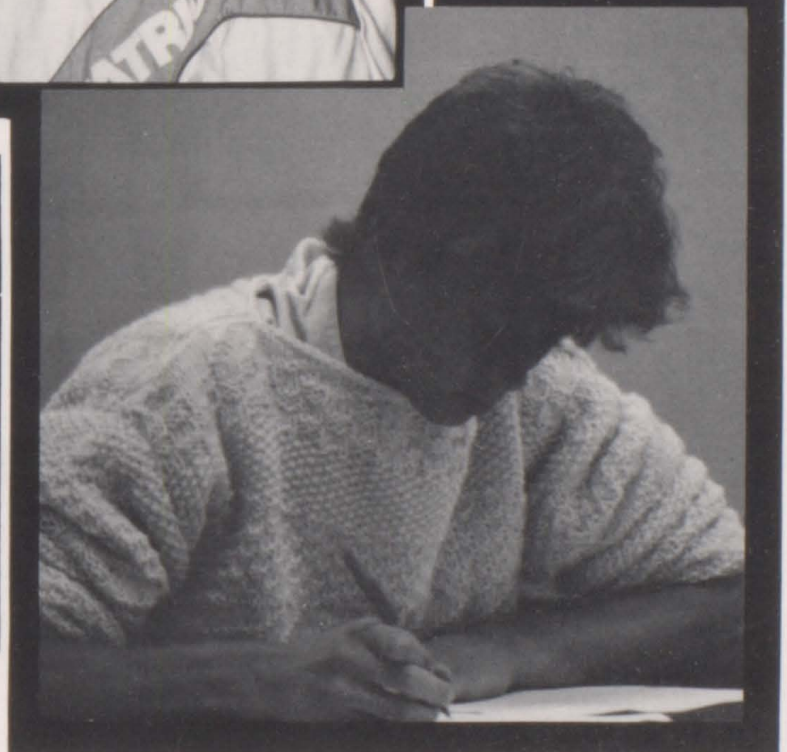
Ikast, Denmark (pop. 13,000)

because horizons never stop.

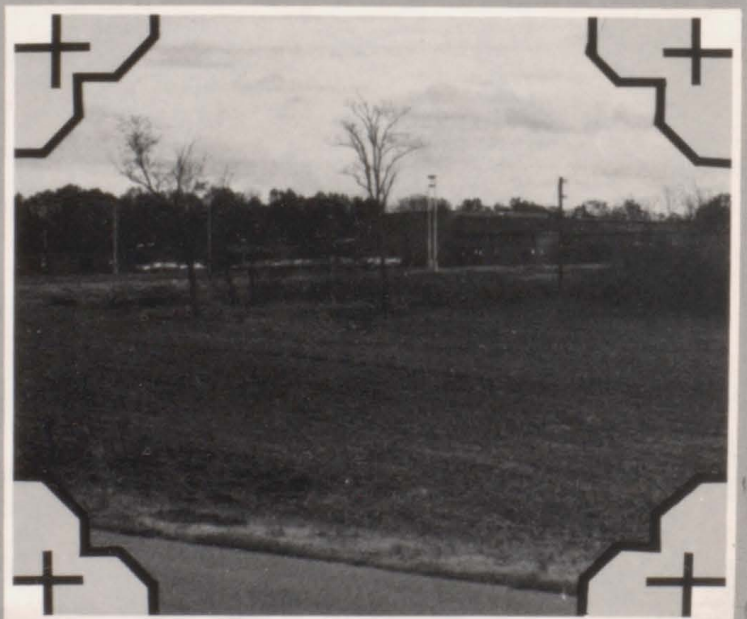
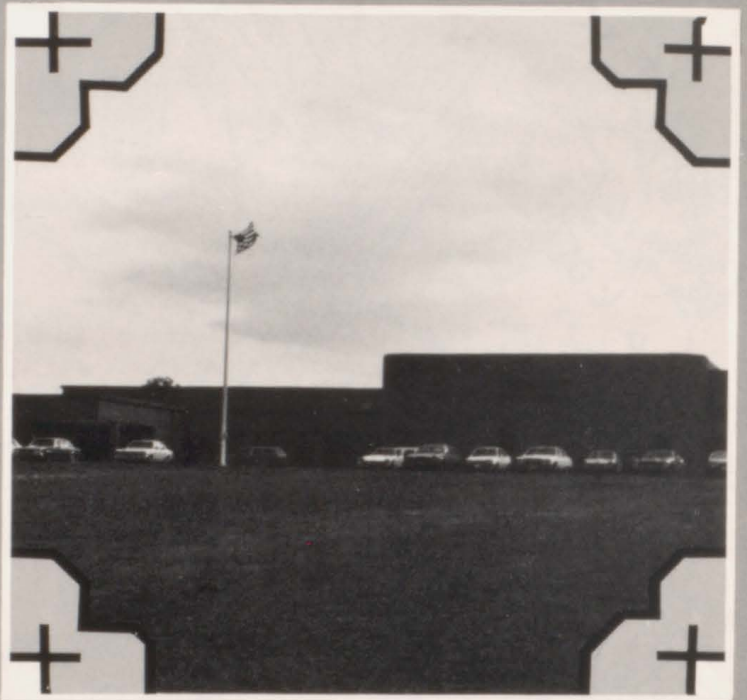
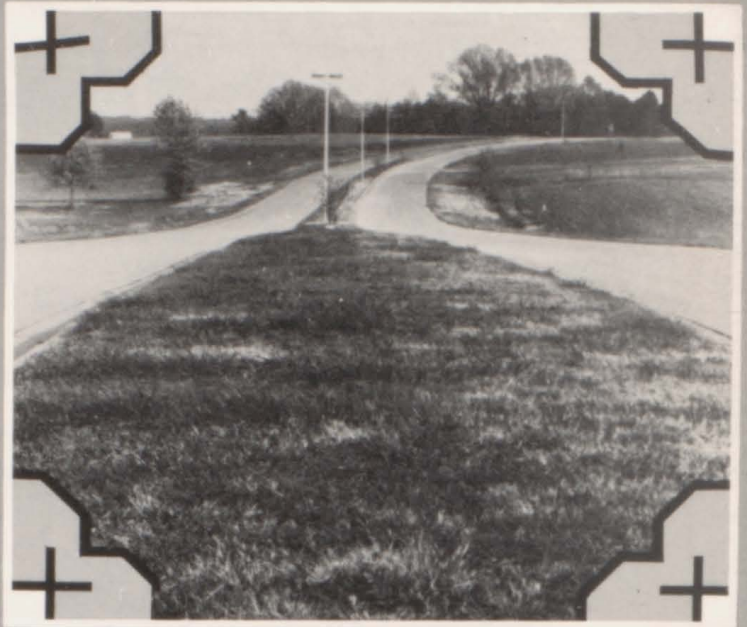
