Beta Club

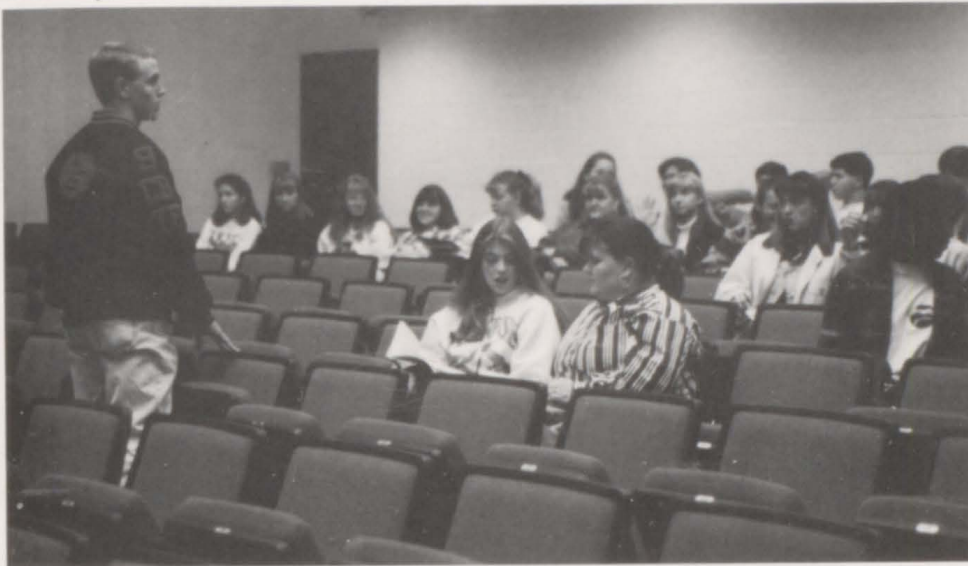

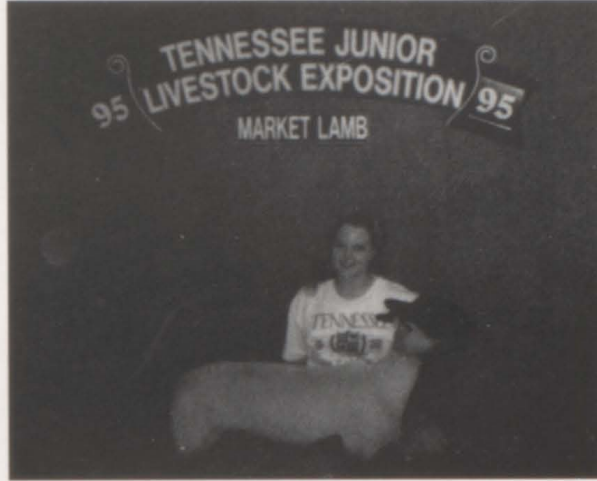

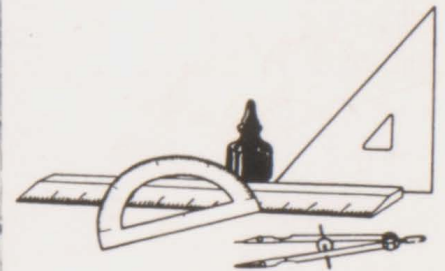


Math Club

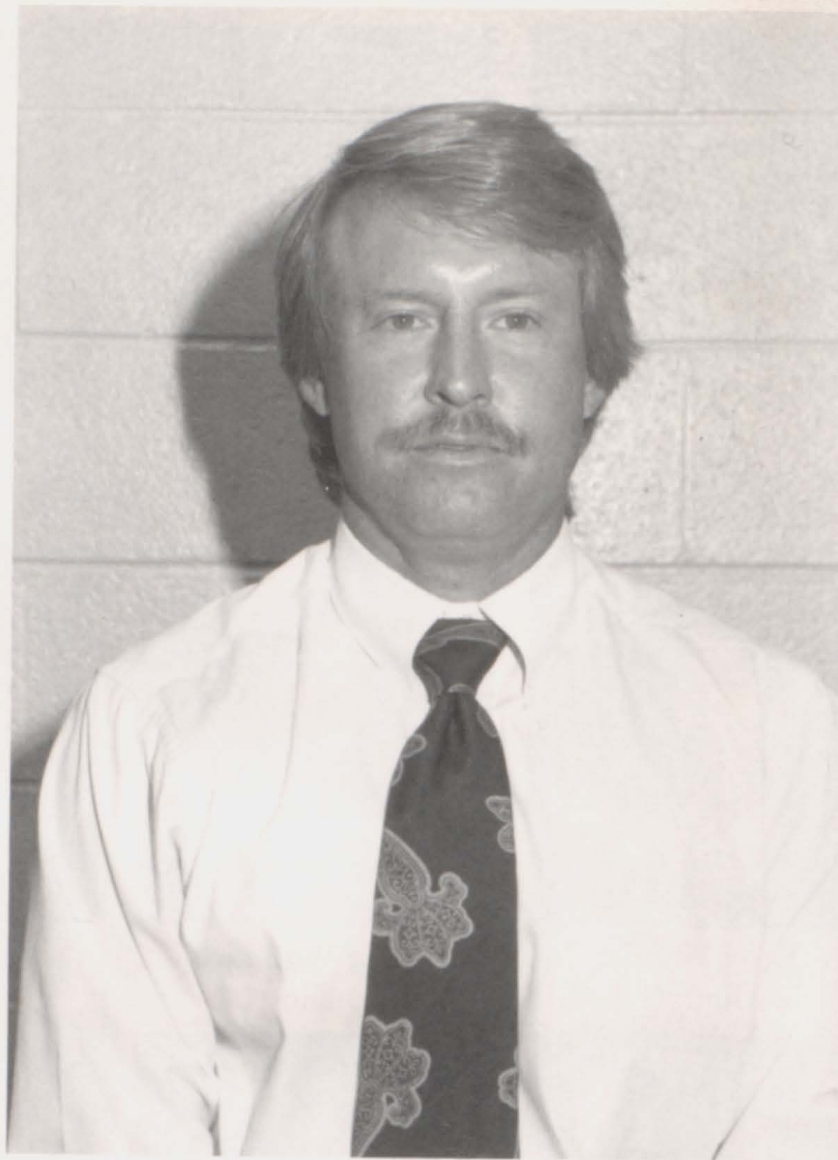
Football

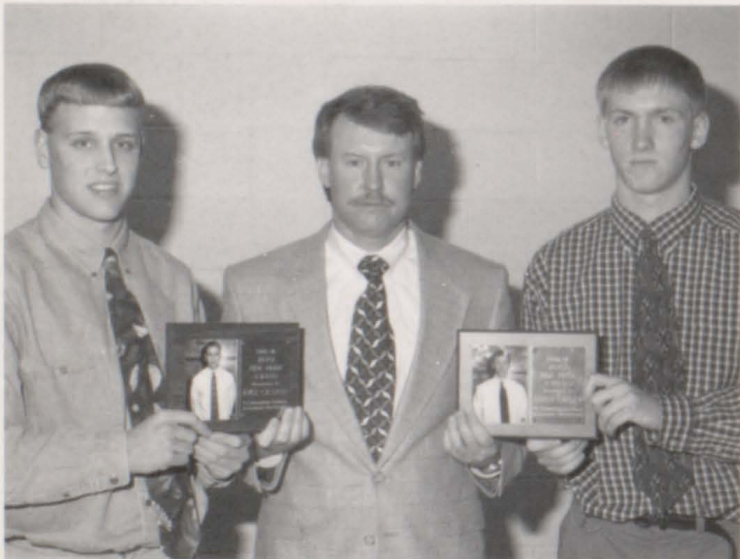

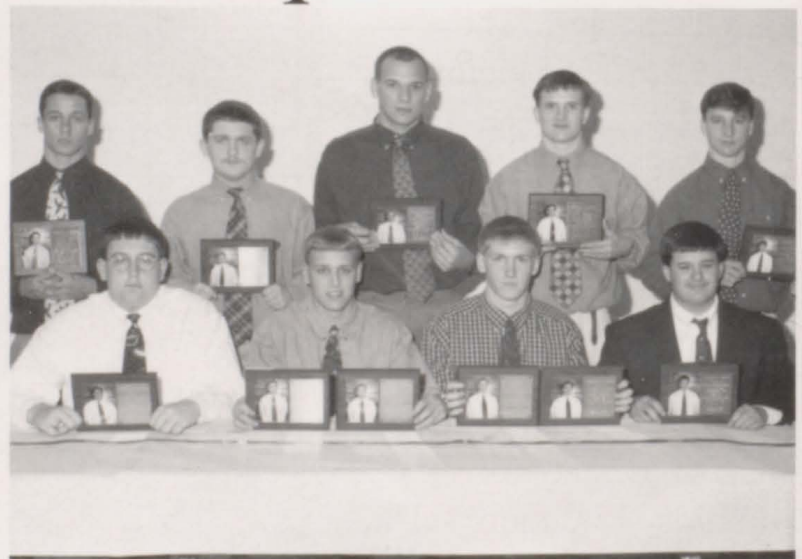

Through much preparation and hard work combined with school spirit, the Peabody Homecoming of 1995 is not one that will soon be forgotten.

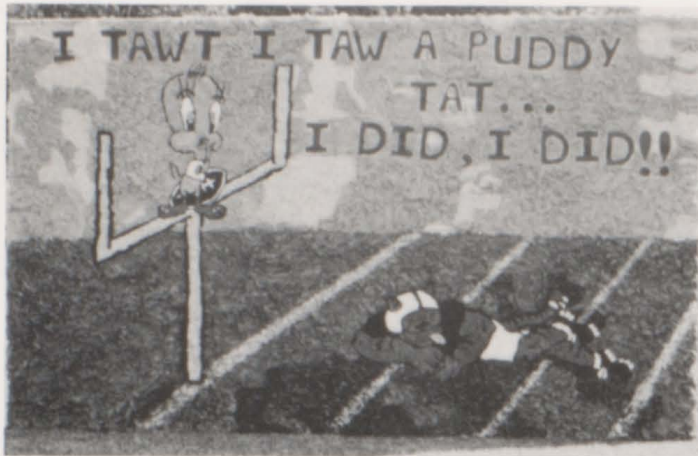
