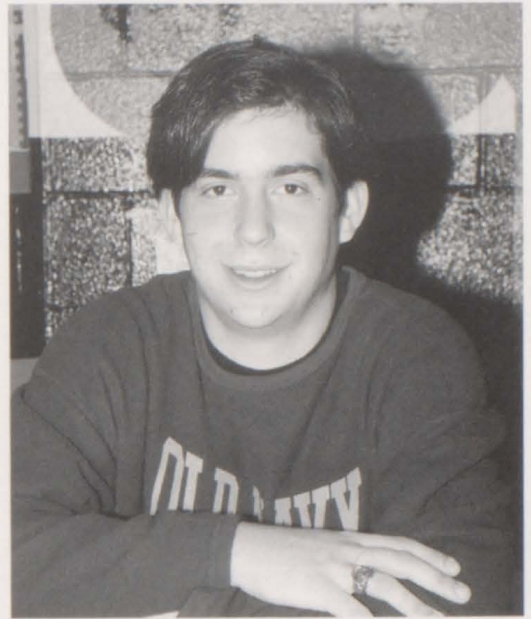


# Governor's School
