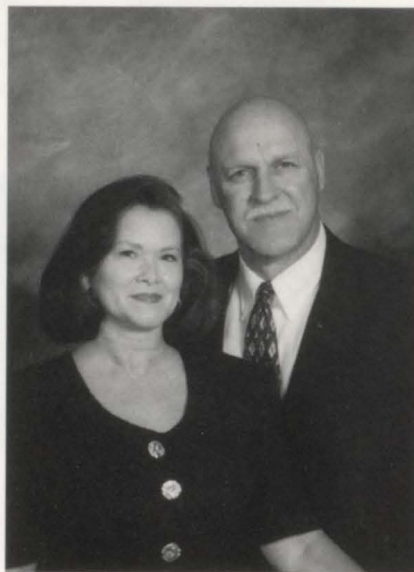
# Dedication
