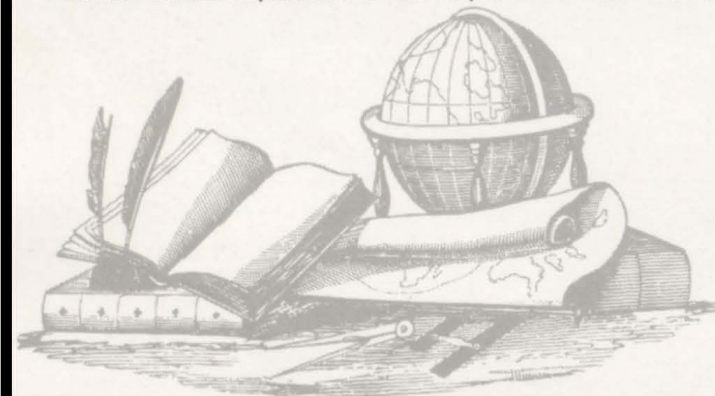
CICILY ABBOTT, JENNIFER FINCH, AND APRIL PHELPS
