# Tidettes win state

*Bring home 'gold' ball for school's first state championship in any sport*

The Peabody Tidettes' 48-44 win over Ezell-Harding in the TSSAA Girls Basketball State Tournament title game proved the sports cliché that offense sells tickets and defense wins championships.

Using a liberal substitute rotation, Peabody coach Steve Patterson built a relentless defensive unit that smothered opposing offenses for entire games. Combining athleticism and depth, the Tidettes proceeded to go undefeated against Class A competition. The state title was Peabody's first in any sport, including both girls and boys.

Peabody's 33-3 record was of special significance. Thirty-three was the number worn by CynKenya Cole, a Tidette player who died tragically while playing in a preseason Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) basketball game between Trenton and Gibson County AAU teams. An abnormal left coronary artery was the cause of death. Cole was described as a natural leader, who led by example. She would have been the only senior on this year's squad.

In memory of Cole, her teammates displayed a photograph and held up three fingers on each hand to signify her number during the tournament

awards ceremony. "If CynKenya was still playing, she would be running things. Since she is not here, all of her teammates knew we had to step it up and take leadership roles. We dedicated the whole season to her. She is always in our thoughts and memories," revealed Jessica Ford.

In addition to the aggressive defense that Coach Patterson credits for winning almost every game, the Tidettes also dominated the game in the categories of rebounding and points scored in the paint. Led by tournament MVP Jessica Bobbitt's 16 caroms, Peabody outrebounded Ezell-Harding 41-23. The Tidettes controlled play inside the lane, with a 30-8 advantage in scoring points inside the paint.

Bobbitt was the enforcer in the lane as she blocked five Ezell-Harding shots, and forced numerous hurries and altered shot trajectory. The presence of the 5-11 sophomore and the play of her tenacious teammates were largely responsible for causing one of the tournament's best shooting teams to make only 11 of 37 shots from two point distance.

The game was extremely (Continued on page 14)
