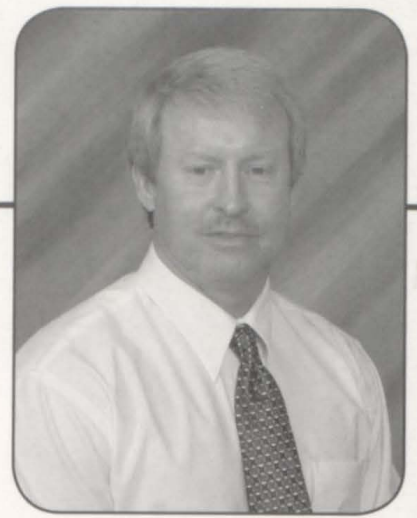
Faculty and Staff

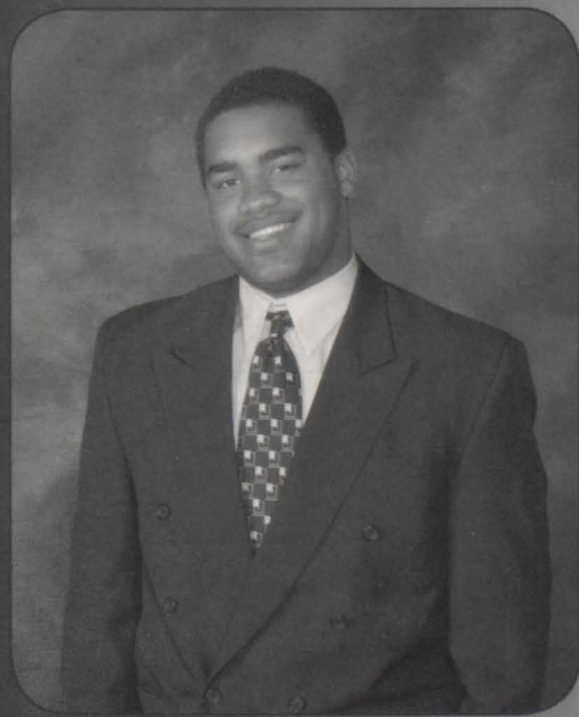
Girls State
