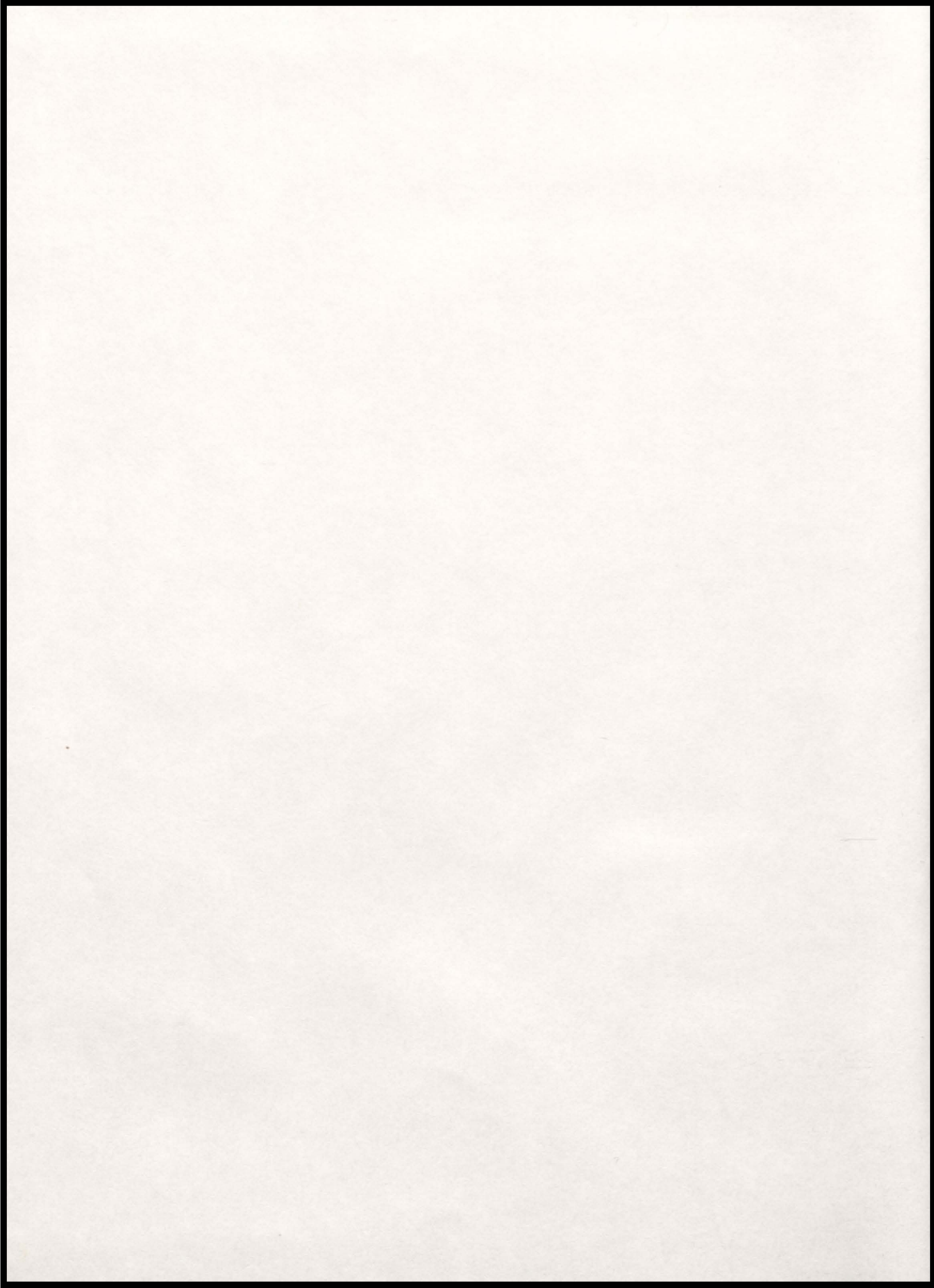

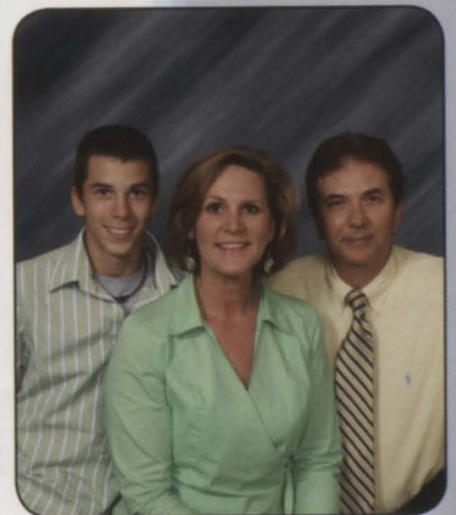
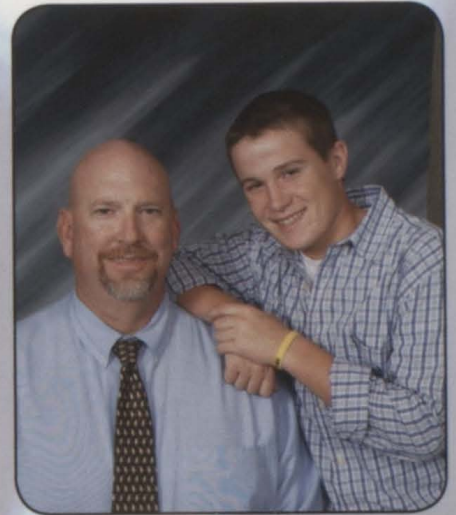
DEDICATION
