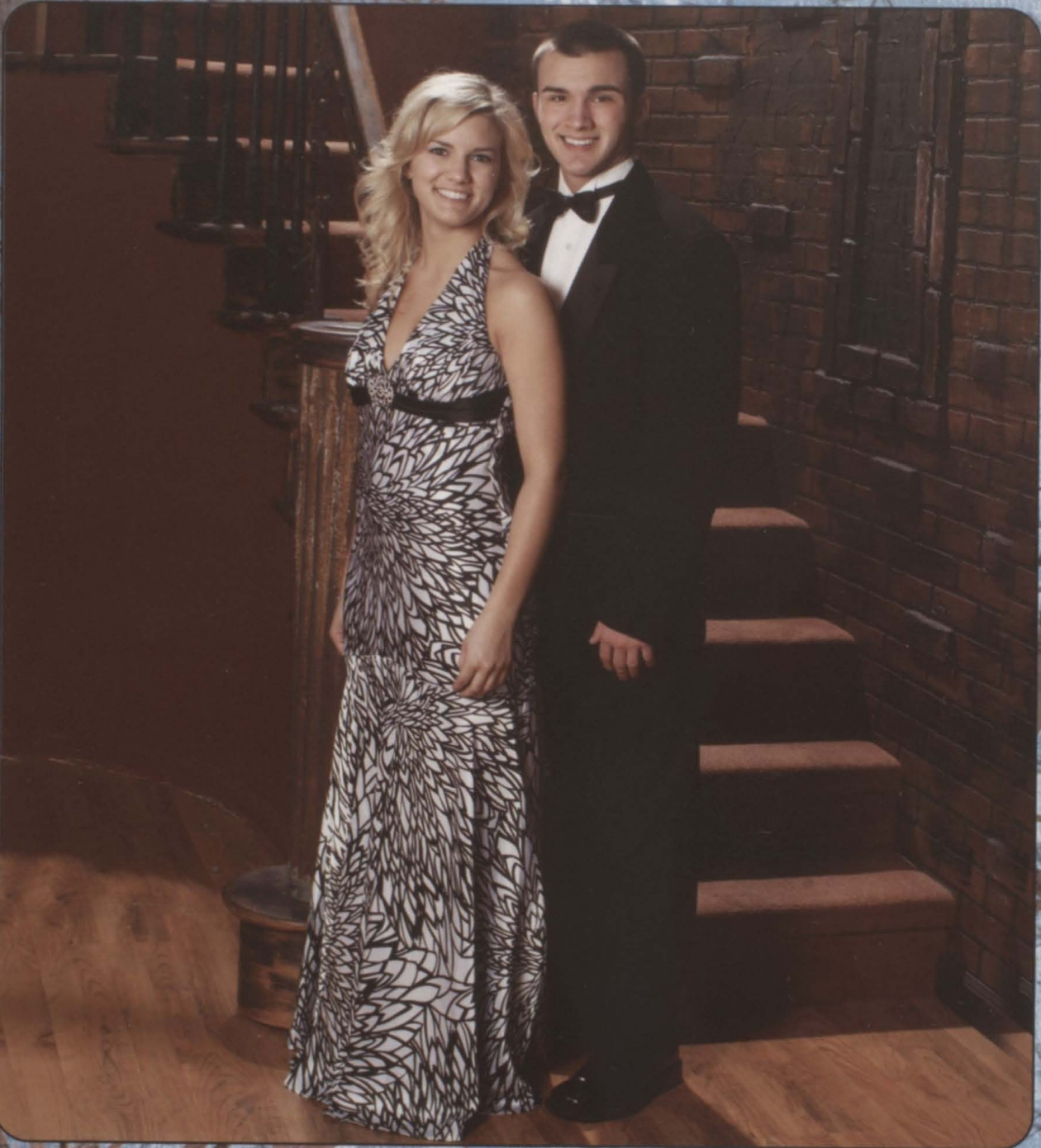
Boys State
