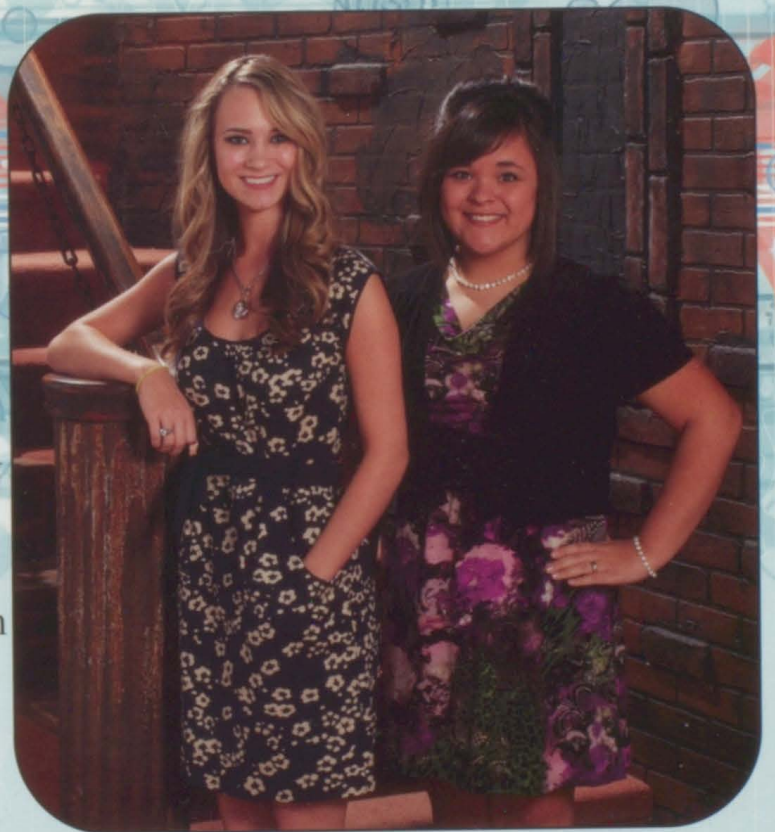
# Girls State
