UPON COMPLETION OF THIS COURSE, PROFICIENT STUDENTS WILL BE PREPARED FOR THE LEVEL-FOUR AGRICULTURAL BUSINESS AND FINANCE COURSE AND ADVANCED STUDY AT A POSTSECONDARY INSTITUTION.
